## Training Report

### Reorientation of Nodal Teachers on Health, Nutrition and Wellbeing of Students in Residential Schools-10<sup>th</sup> May to 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2018



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## 1.INTRODUCTION TO LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION PLUS PROGRAMME

Odisha state has a population of nearly 42 million and one out of every five person is an adolescent<sup>1</sup>. The state has the privilege of having the highest number (13) of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) and two-fifth of the population is constituted by Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Scheduled Caste (SC)<sup>2</sup>. In order to enhance the reach and access to education for disadvantaged communities, the Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Caste Development, Minorities and Backward Classes Welfare Department (SSD) has established residential schools. Odisha is one of the leading states in the country providing free residential education facilities for children from the Scheduled Tribe and Scheduled Caste communities. Currently, the department runs 1670 residential schools consisting of 510 *Seva Ashram* (primary) schools, 766 *Ashram schools* (middle schools- 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> standards), 337 High schools, 19 Education Complex (1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> standard) for the particularly vulnerable tribal groups (PVTG), 13 *Eklavya* model residential schools (EMRS-CBSE), 22 Upgraded Higher Secondary Schools and 3 Teachers Training Institute. These residential schools are spread across the state and cater to over 550,000 students of which 60% are girls.

Young girls and boys from the ST and SC communities face a number of challenges on several fronts. Among them, the adolescent girls from the tribal communities, are the most disadvantaged and often face challenges preventing them from realizing their full potential. This includes dropping out at secondary levels (high schools), poor nutrition, child marriage, teenage pregnancy, sexual abuse, lack of choices and such others. Further, many boys and girls are first generation learners and are also highly vulnerable to joining left wing extremist groups.

### *Life Skills Education Programme so far*

United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), in its County Programme – 8, was able to successfully advocate and introduce the life skills education programme in residential schools of the ST and SC Development department. UNFPA is partnering with the Scheduled Caste Scheduled Tribe Research and Training Institute (SCSTRTI), Government of Odisha since April 2015 for the programme. The focus of the programme is to empower adolescents with knowledge and life skills and to create an enabling environment in tribal residential schools for their safer and informed growing up process.

Initially, the LSE programme reached out to students in classes 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> and thereafter was expanded to cover 7<sup>th</sup> standard. A fixed period on a weekly basis is allocated in the school's timetable for LSE and students are transacted 28 planned sessions by trained teachers on topics of personal hygiene, nutrition, common communicable diseases, changes during adolescence, myths and misconceptions around growing up, early marriage and teen age

pregnancy, HIV/AIDS, gender discrimination, dealing with peer pressure, abuse and sexual harassment and such others through a life skills approach.

In order to create an enabling environment and to empower adolescents with Life's Skills, numerous activities were organized under the UNFPA's Life Skills Education programme. Between 2015 and 2017, UNFPA supported training of nearly 2000 teachers, 260 ANMs, more than 2000 matrons and nearly 300 supervisory cadre officials of the ST and SC Development department under the programme. In addition, sensitization and advocacy programmes were organized reaching out to nearly 4000 key stakeholders which included district and block level officials of the ST and SC Development department as well as officials of other line departments and NGOs, with a specific focus on safety, security and wellbeing of students in residential schools. UNFPA also closely worked with the department and assisted in developing Standard Operating Protocols (SOPs), code of conduct for students and staff in residential schools and school monitoring checklist for supervisory cadre officials. This was followed up by sensitization programmes at various levels. While the LSE sessions were transacted with students of classes 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup>; the other support covered all residential schools.

The department accords high priority for safety, security and wellbeing of students and has taken up several measures in addition to issuing guidelines and circulars from time to time. Some of these measures included recruitment of nearly 3000 matrons, 330 ANMs, establishment of a central monitoring unit, placing hotline phones at girls' hostel, introduction of toll free number for compliant registration and an overall effort for improving the management of residential schools.

#### *New Partnership*

During 2017, the *Azim Premji Philanthropic Initiative*(APPI) expressed an interest to collaborate with UNFPA to build on the existing platform of life skills education programme, with a focus on health, nutrition and wellbeing of adolescents from the ST and SC communities. This is in line with the Odisha Nutrition Action Plan which is being supported by APPI and involves intensifying and broad basing the interventions. The UNFPA-APPI partnership is for a period of three years starting February 2018 (2018-2020) - Government approval enclosed in **Annexure -1** and the support is towards three broad areas which are as follows:

- (a) Strengthen monitoring mechanisms for residential schools including introduction of IT based applications and tools
- (b) Scale up LSE programme to upper primary classes covering 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> standards with an emphasis on ARSH and nutrition
- (c) Facilitate intersectoral convergence for health and nutrition of adolescents in residential schools

While some of the components under the project will be implemented by SCSTRTI through the UNFPA supported Work Plan; others will be directly supported by UNFPA and APPI.

APPI will support in strengthening monitoring systems including introduction of IT tools. This will include creating a robust database of ST, SC students in residential schools, establishing an integrated portal for monitoring, applications and dashboards for existing school monitoring system, SMS based mechanisms for daily status checks from hostels and application for ANMs to track health status of students. The IT based support will be sourced by APPI and UNFPA will provide technical support for developing and rolling it out in close collaboration with the department through the LSE plus project.

A joint committee, consisting of officials from the department, APPI and UNFPA will finalize the parameters to be captured under various applications. Similarly, some of the activities will be directly supported by UNFPA. This will include support for human resources at state and district levels, development of resource and communication materials including multi-media packages and procurement of equipment as required under the project. At the district level, intensive monitoring support will be provided in 13 districts having high concentration of tribal residential schools in a phased manner. In the first phase (2018), the support will be extended to five tribal districts namely *Kandhamal, Keonjhar, Koraput, Gajapati and Rayagada*. In the second phase, (2019 and 2020) the support will be extended to another eight districts (*Kalahandi, Malkanagiri, Mayurbhanj, Nabarangapur, Sundargarh, Nuapada, Bolangir and Sambalpur*).

## I. Coverage

- i. Over 200,000 adolescent girls and boys from the ST and SC communities studying in classes 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> standards in government residential schools across 13 districts of Odisha (*Kandhamal, Keonjhar, Koraput, Gajapati, Rayagada, Kalahandi, Malkanagiri, Mayurbhanj, Nabarangapur, Sundargarh, Nuapada, Bolangir and Sambalpur*) through the life skills education.
- ii. The ST and SC Development Department through strengthened systems, monitoring mechanisms (IT application, dashboard, SMS based mechanism for daily status check from hostels, application for ANMs, supervisory cadre officials, etc.) and improved capacities of functionaries.

## II. Geographical Coverage

- Thirty districts across the state
  - 2018 – 5 districts, 395 residential schools of five districts namely *Kandhamal, Keonjhar, Koraput, Gajapati and Rayagada* through intensive monitoring support

- 2019-2020 - 893 residential schools across 13 districts *Kandhamal, Keonjhar, Koraput, Gajapati, Rayagada, Kalahandi, Malkanagiri, Mayurbhanj, Nabarangapur, Sundargarh, Nuapada, Bolangir and Sambalpur.*

### III. Objectives

Health, nutrition and wellbeing of adolescents, especially girls from SC and ST communities studying in residential schools under the department.

#### Specific Objectives

- i. Enhance knowledge and skills among adolescents through the life skills education covering 893 residential schools across 13 districts of Odisha
- ii. Promote student friendly environment in 1670 residential schools by improving monitoring mechanism, introduction of IT based applications and engagement of key stakeholders
- iii. Facilitate convergence with health sector initiatives (*Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram - RBSK, Rashtriya Kishore Swasthya Karyakram - RKSK*), and improve referral and response mechanisms.

### 2. SELECTION OF NODAL TEACHERS

Guidelines has been issued to districts for implementation of life skills education plus programme in SSD schools. As a part of annual action plan first and foremost task was identification and selection of nodal teachers for reorientation on life skills education plus programme. The district welfare officers with support of technical support unit team members have undertaken selection process in consultation with respective Head Masters of schools. It was decided to select at least two nodal teachers from each school under the intervention. The following are the key consideration for selection of the nodal teachers;

- A. Preference for lady teachers
- B. Preference for the teachers who are residing in the campus
- C. Teachers who are close to students (Student's friendly)

During the year 2018, 790 teachers have been selected and list submitted to SCSTRTI for undertaking training programme.

### **3.REORIENTATION OF NODAL TEACHERS**

Based on objective of the programme a need assessment was undertaken for finalization of training schedule and content. The PMU-LSE team have interacted with stakeholders like; Ass. Teachers, Hostel Superintendent, Head Masters, WEOs, and District Level Officers for identifying the gaps and recommending trust areas for training of nodal teachers on Life Skills Education plus programme and finalized the content of the training programme. For undertaking the training programme around 20 master trainers were engaged and interactive sessions were planned for capacity building of nodal teachers. In order to, trained these 790 teachers 20 batches of training programme were planned in May'2018. The Akankhya Urban hostel at kalinga Nagar, Bhubaneswar was identified as the training venues for the said month long training programme. The training plan and official letters is attached in **Annexure – 2(A,B,C,D,E)**

- **ENGAGEMENT OF MASTER TRAINERS**

There are around 20 Trained Freelance Master Trainers and 13 no. of Technical Support Unit Members are available for undertaking the training programme. As there are four parallel batches of the training programme planned in each slot appropriate trainers were empanelled for each training batches. For each training batches one master trainer, one supporting and one logistic assistant was engaged for smooth and organization of training programme. The list of master trainers is enclosed in **Annexure- 3**

- **COMMUNICATION AND RESOURCE TOOLS**

Appropriate need based communication and resource tools on LSE and ARSH were contextualized for use during nodal teachers training programme. The training manual, Frequently Asked Question (FAQ) and other communication and resource tools widely use during these training programme. A part from these tools, different case studies stimulation exercises were also used for organizing group activities during these training programmes.

- NEEDBASED TRAINING SCHEDULED

Based on need assessment the suitable contents were identified for capacity building of nodal teacher on life skills education. The contents covered life skills; growing up process, issues and concerns of adolescences, Nutrition, prevention of RTI/STI and HIV/AIDS, early marriage and teenage pregnancy and handling peer pressure and substance misuses. Apart from that contents were incorporated on safety and security guideline and defining role clarity among stakeholders. Specific sessions were taken on developing counseling skills of the nodal teachers and making gender sensitivity. Considering the health and hygienic concern in schools specific sessions were taken on promoting health practices and prevention of communicable diseases. Adequate steps were taken for making these sessions interactive and participatory. The activities like; role play, group work, case study analysis, open discussions were undertaken for enabling the nodal teachers to understand the themes and internalize for its applications. The training scheduled is enclosed **Annexure- 4**

- PROCEEDING OF THE TRAINING PROGRAMME

On the first day of the training program, there was an inauguration session in which the Director and Special Secretary SCSTRTI Dr.A.B.Otta, State Programme Coordinator of UNFPA Dr.Deepa Prasad, Senior Consultant to Govt. School and hostel monitoring Unit Ms. Sony Rout , Ms. Sweta Mishra, Gender and youth consultant to UNFPA joined and inspired the first batch of school teachers. Many of the practical aspects regards to the safety security as well as wellbeing of the students were discussed and the concept of “Event Free Year” was the focused among other touched subjects during the opening event.

The training was designed to facilitate batch wise sessions with well-trained and experienced resource persons both from filed as well as state level panels. Prior to each batch the assigned resource persons along with the state PMU would sit and discuss various challenges and needs which was one of the well taken strategies to ensure the quality of the training sessions.

There was also one preparatory cum orientation meeting organized for the Resource team on 9<sup>th</sup> of May 2018 to introduce the newly compiled Audio Video resource materials &

We have conducted eight training batches (each batch was alienated into two or three parallel moving batches according to the registration and accommodation for smooth execution of the training sessions) including one drop out batch during the period ,10<sup>th</sup> May 2018 to 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2018.

Each training batch was designed to accommodate the following reorientation sessions

- Safety and security guidelines, POCSO Act and its application
- Life skills approaches to address the anemia among students in residential schools
- Balance diet

- Adolescent Reproductive Sexual Health
- Growing up and changes during adolescence
- Early marriage, teen age pregnancy
- RTI/STI and HIV AIDS
- Myth and misconceptions around ARSH
- 25 Sessions on Life Skill Education
- Planning to undertake the planed sessions and reporting
- Communication and resource materials
- Reporting
- Preparation of Action plan
- Adolescent Counseling-(Demonstration on counseling)

Many of the sessions were planned for group discussion and followed with presentation or practical demonstration. Subject related Skits, Cooperative games, Panel discussions were

among the clarifying act of instruments to make the training more effective as well as operative.

As school level reporting is one of the key indicators, the district concerned DPOs took the responsibility to clarify different reporting and documenting formats. There was also dedicated times during the session where they could able to discuss regarding the flow of information, identification of Case study & Best practices along with time line.

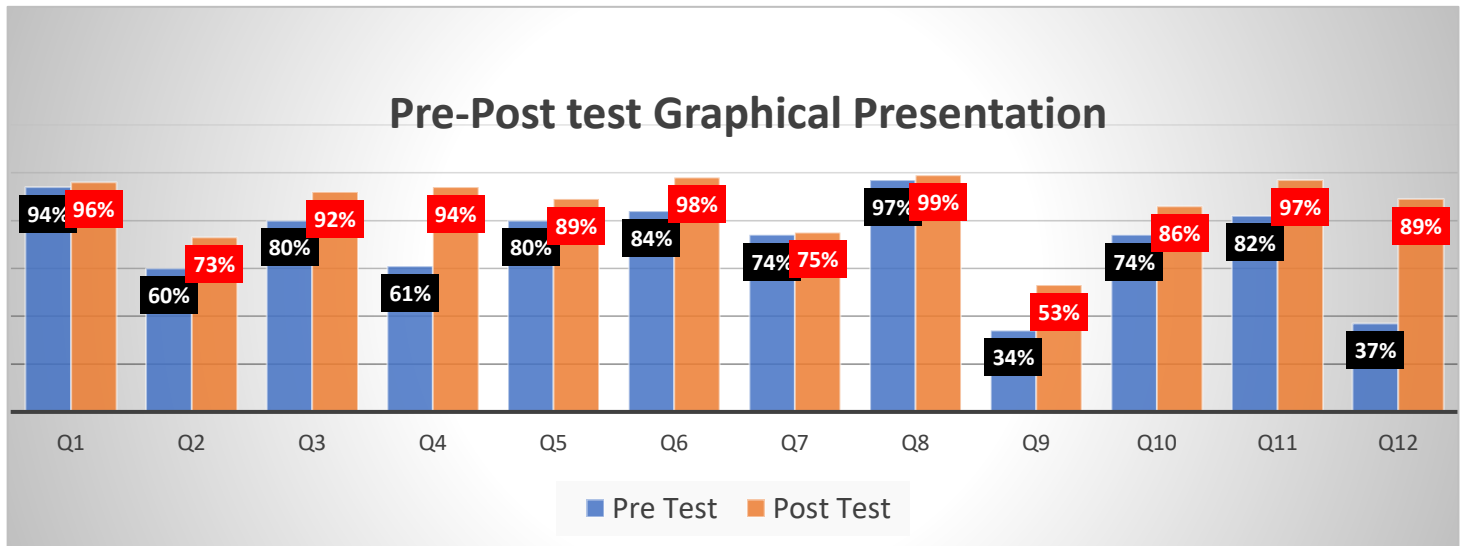

### 4.FEEDBACK AND ASESSMENT

As mentioned above that the pre and post analysis was conducted for each and every batch aiming for the assessment of the qualitative aspects of our sessions. An appropriate Pre and Post questionnaire were designed in order to assess Knowledge, Attitude, and Practices (KAP) on Life Skills Education and ARSH of participating teachers. The assessment area constitutes Life Skills Education, Health Practices, Diseases prevention, Nutrition and Safety and Security of Students of the schools. The pre and Post questionnaire is enclosed **Annexure- 6,6A**

If we can see the below graphical presentation of the 8 batches of the training program. It is clearly visible that the knowledge level of the teachers have increased with a significant growth percentage. For the information, though it was a reorientation program for the school teachers but as we are focusing on nutrition and safety security of the students, the notable knowledge growth in question no 4 (Question related to Session-Nutrition ) and Question no 8 (Question related to Session safety security guidelines) is visible.

Similarly there is noteworthy hikes in the question bars of 2,6,9,11 and 12 which is mostly related to the Communicable diseases and Adolescent reportative health and rights.



## FEED BACK

A parallel questioner was developed to get the feed backs of participants for the improvement in class room session facilitation, Training needs as well as matters related to safety and security of the students.

**Some of the compiled Feed backs of the teachers in the below mentioned topics according to the given questionnaire.**

### Questions related to Safety & Security

- No student should be asked to go to any staff quarters for any reason whatsoever
- Requires compulsory staff quarters for residing of staffs / hostel superintendent in hostel premises to look into better safety of the boarders.
- Weakly & monthly meeting of teaching and non-teaching staffs should be organized on safety and security at school.
- Boundary wall of Girls schools / hostels must be heightened.
- Should follow the Guideline & instruction given by the department.
- Extra Security guard / watch ward should be engaged at the main gate of school premises for the better safety security of students.
- Discuss some live events (Case studies) on Safety security with students and orient them regarding the steps for prevention.
- Orientation and of PTA/ SMC/SMDC members on Safety & security frequently.
- Requires CCTV surveillance in the hostel premises for better safety & security.

- 3 tire securities system should be developed in School and hostel premises.

### **Questions related to effective LSE programme**

- Requires more IEC ( Audio & visual) materials on ARSH
- Reference manuals (students) with work book should provide to each student.
- Some real case studies on ARSH should be shared by the Nodal teachers for betterment.
- Selection and Orientation of more peer educators ( especially for solving the SRH issues among them)
- Tutor mentor method should be adopted for the better implementation of LSE programme.
- Half yearly test / assessment of students on LSE should be done for better result.

### **6.WAY FORWARD**

The trained nodal teachers are the ambassadors for taking forward the life skills plus education programme to residential schools. During the two days reorientation programme the participating nodal teachers not only oriented on contents of LSE Plus programme but also oriented on how to take forward this initiative to students in residential schools for promoting safety, security, health and nutrition. The reference materials were provided to teachers and resource kits containing resource materials and audio video tools were provided to schools for awareness building among students. It is expected the trained teachers will undertake life skills sessions in fixed weekly period and need based counseling will be undertaken for addressing the needs for healthy growing up process and nutrition of students in residential schools. The teachers will also support for organization of Adolescent Health Days (AHDs) in residential schools in coordination with Block Health Team/ Rastriya Bal Sawasthya Karakram (RBSK) and support ANMs in maintaining the health profile of students.

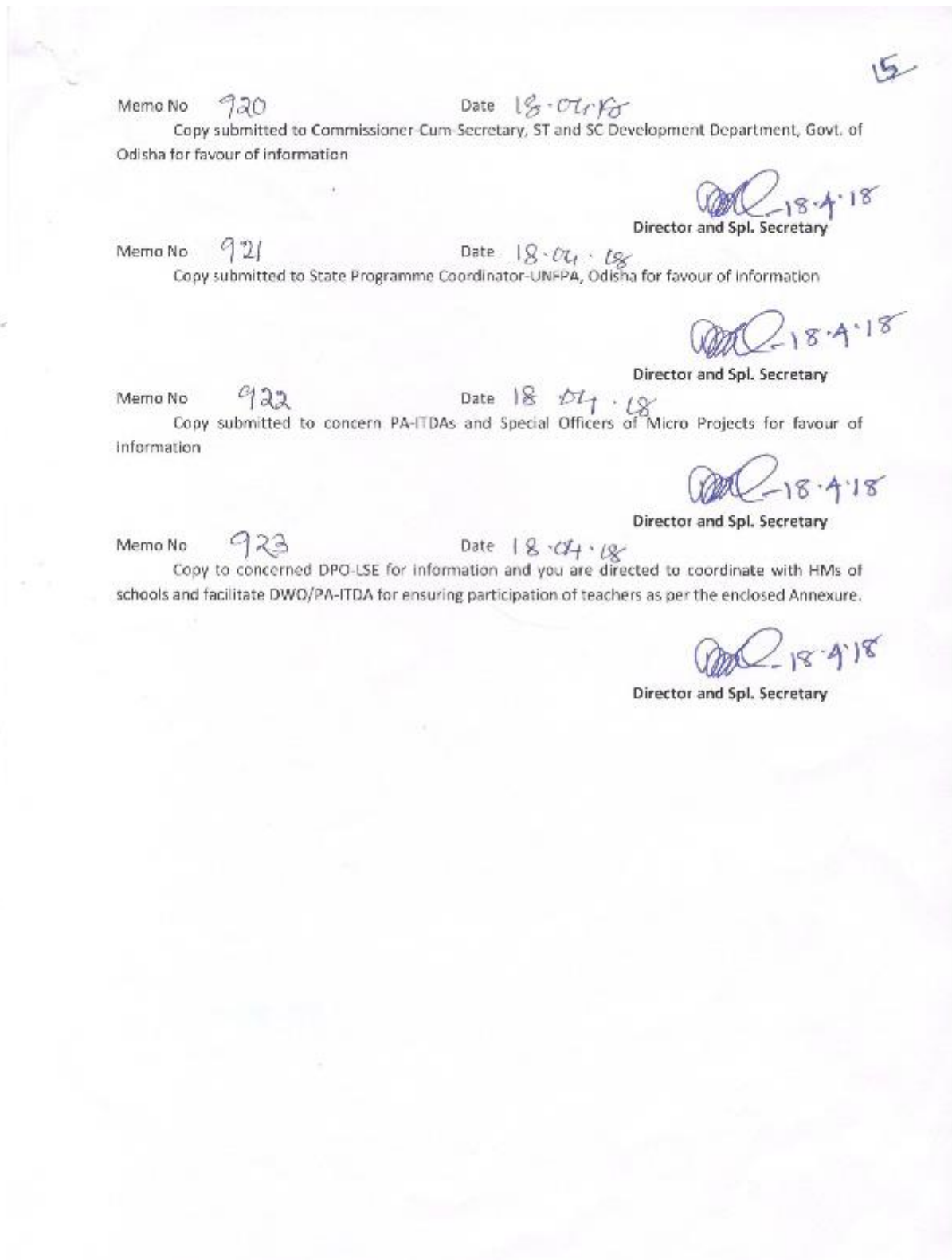
